The Joliet Generating Station is located in Will County on approximately 463 acres. Unit 6 is located on one side of the Des Plaines River and Units 7 and 8 are on the other side. In summer 2016, the plant was permanently converted from coal to natural gas.

Community Involvement

Joliet Station employees are members and supporters of the following: Joliet Chamber of Commerce, Three Rivers Manufacturing Association, Will County Chamber of Commerce, Hill Memorial Center after-school program, Joliet Park Foundation, Joliet Township High School, Will County Center for Economic Development, Joliet Junior College Honors Program Scholarships. Employees have also contributed to the United Way of Will County.

Sustainability

NRG invested significantly to convert the Joliet Station to operate on cleaner natural gas in 2016, significantly reducing emissions at the station.

Including other major investments in environmental improvements across the entire IL coal fleet, these changes have resulted in:

- A reduction of at least 16 million tons per year of carbon emissions (60% of existing emission levels)
- A 90% reduction in SO₂ emissions
- A 65% reduction in NO_x emissions
- An investment of about \$567 million in the MWG fleet
